Introduction and philosophy:

According to the collaboration between Iran federation and UIAA, Iran won the nomination for holding youth camp of 2015, 2016 and 2017. The first camp was held successfully in Damavand Mount, 5671 meters; also the Second camp was held based on technical climb in Sabalan mount. As a result, the Youth Commission voted again for hosting this international event in Iran for 2017.



In 2016 our commissions successfully hosted 22 participants from 7 different Asian and Europian countries, such as great members of Afghanistan federation, president of this organization, named Sedigheh Norestani, and participants from Island, India and Turkey; and 94

Iranian climbers including members of Youth National Team.

The youth camp was held in Iran to maintain these purposes:

- A chance for youth climbers to become familiar with Iran's nature and social environment.
- Getting to know mountains and continent of Iran.
- Sharing cultural differences and experience cultural and social exchange.
- Teaching Ice and snow techniques with experienced instructors.
- Creating significant communication between Iran youth climbers and foreign climbers.
- Obtaining international status in UIAA and among related commissions.

Damavand 5671 meter

High, magnificent adventure spot, sub active volcano

Mt. Damavand is highest peak of Iran and the most prominent feature of Iran looming majestically near the southern coast of the Caspian Sea, also highest point in Middle East.





The highest volcano of the Asia is well-known for its volcanic crater and very unique wild flowers named as Mountain Tulip (Tulipa Montana). You can see this special flower mainly in June.



Accommodations:

Polour Camp: Polour is one of the cities near Damavand which is located 80 kilometers away from Tehran. Iran Mountaineering Federation has an equipped shelter in this area. With comfortable rooms, no sleeping bag and extra water bottle is needed there.

Mosque, Camp 1, Goosfand Sara (3040 m): You will be transferred from Polour to the mosque by 4*4 Jeeps. Your trekking will be started there and you will spend maximum 5 hours to get to the Camp3, Bargah Sevom.

<u>Bargah Sevom, Camp 3</u>: This Hut is last campsite of the Damavand Southern route. There is space for sleeping but tent spots around the hut is highly recommended due to the massive crowd in summer time. There would be light warm meal and some snacks, also bottled water to buy in the market. Toilets are outside.







Alam kuh 4848 meter

This very beautiful and rocky mountain is located in North of Iran, Kelardast district and lays

across the Alborz range. lots of peaks surrounded the main Alam-Kuh summit which is the second highest mountain of Iran, 4,848 meters.

The Glaciers and routes with different difficulties make this mountain a very unique spot for technical training.

Hesarchal area, a huge flat ground where we set our camp is very colorful and green with majestic scenery during Summer time.
